Recycling and Waste Collection. Collections are normally on Mondays for most addresses in the villages; recycling (the green wheelie) and general rubbish (the grey/black wheelie) are emptied fortnightly on alternate Mondays. Food waste (the small green bin) is emptied weekly along with other bins. Garden waste (brown) is emptied fortnightly with the recycling bin; this service is an optional paid subscription through the District Council. Please remember to put your bins out on Sunday night as sometimes collections can be early on Monday mornings. Note that the Waste Recycling Centre ('the Tip') is located on the A417 north of Stanford-in-the Vale.
