Aims and Objectives for 2019 / 2020

Aims

- To provide effective, efficient and accountable local government for the parish, and communicate our plans, actions and achievements, enabling residents to be involved in its future development.
- To be a strong voice for residents, working to improve the overall village area, both built and natural, while preserving the setting and character of heritage areas.

Objectives

- Ensure ongoing compliance with all legislation pertaining to local government
- Continue to sponsor, encourage and assist the Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group, through to the referendum and adoption of the Neighbourhood Plan for Uffington and Baulking
- Consolidate the achievements of the last four years, working together as a new Council after May 2019
- Improve communications in the village
- Continue to consider very carefully all applications for planning permission
- Monitor approved projects utilising S106 / CIL funding and consider any further eligible applications
- Prepare an Emergency Plan for the village
- Manage in a cost –effective way the assets of the Council
