Aims

Objectives

- Work to close off any remaining actions in the CLP
- Continue to consider very carefully all applications for planning permission
- Monitor approved projects utilising S106 funding and consider any further eligible applications
- Work to ensure that the necessary funding is in place to enable the essential repairs to the Old Schoolroom to be completed in 2018/19
- Work with the Uffington Museum Trustees to bring the management structure up to date
- Prepare an Emergency Plan for the village
- Manage in a cost –effective way the assets of the Council
- Keep abreast of the implications for the village of the Better
 Oxfordshire unitary proposal and respond accordingly
