Council Aim

Objectives (2022/23)

- 2. Provide a strong voice for all residents whilst working with them to achieve the aim.
- 3. Communicate out plans, actions and achievements to enable residents to comment on and be involved in the development of our village.
- 4. Manage and maintain, in a safe and cost-effective way, the assets of the Council including the Old School Room.
- 5. Consider very carefully, and comment on as necessary, all planning applications for Planning permission, ensuring to the best of our ability that they all comply with the policies of the Vale of White Horse District Council Development Plan, including the adopted Uffington and Baulking Neighbourhood Plan.
- 6. Monitor sponsored projects utilising S106 funding and consider and prioritise any further eligible applications.
- 7. Deliver approved Council projects.
- 8. Encourage and support within the parish all relevant policies and initiatives of the UK Government, Oxfordshire County Council and the Vale of the White Horse District Council relating to climate change and sustainability of our Environment.
